

## Position Paper II: Why Masks? Brad Fregger

The Proceedings for the National Academy of Sciences published a paper supporting the CDC call for masks to limit the spread of the Covid series of viruses.

I criticized the paper as being incomplete and misleading.

I was asked to clarify my response, here are my clarifying comments. The article suggests that the level of laboratory research showing the effectiveness of masks to trap tiny drops of respiration prove that they will minimize the spread of the virus. In addition, they quoted other research that suggested that masks must be effective and so they must be worn.

However, there is not a single reference to the research done on thousands of people and the actual data from the United States and the Scandinavian countries which clearly shows that the masks have, essentially, no impact on the spread of the virus. If it had referenced that research and the actual CDC data, it would have been a more balanced paper.

There is no doubt that if you are in close proximity to an individual with Covid-19 that the masks will provide a level of protection. However, if the individual is asymptomatic it is extremely difficult for them to spread any infection.

As it is, it essentially justifies the CDC position. The problem: At the top levels, the CDC is a progressive globalist organization dedicated to supporting progressive globalist propaganda.

This is shown to be obvious when an honest CDC researcher or spokesperson makes a statement which is much closer to the truth but has to back step it the next day.

For example, recently a CDC spokesperson stated, "60 percent of new cases are vaccinated people, only 40 percent are unvaccinated." They didn't just mention this in passing, they emphasized it. Then the next day they stated that they meant it the other way around. The questions are: "Which statement was the truth?" and "Was the spokesperson pressured to make the change?" However, 40 percent is still problematic.

There are plenty of progressive globalists in politics, medicine, science, and, of course, academics—even in our community.

While a few are globalists focused for ultimate wealth and power, the majority actually believe that we can only solve critical global societal issues (over population, human-caused catastrophic global warming, world peace, etc.) with a world government. As such

- 3. As with all communist/socialist governments, the leaders will get massively wealthy and the people will become much poorer. ... but, equally poor so equity, on that level, will have been achieved.
